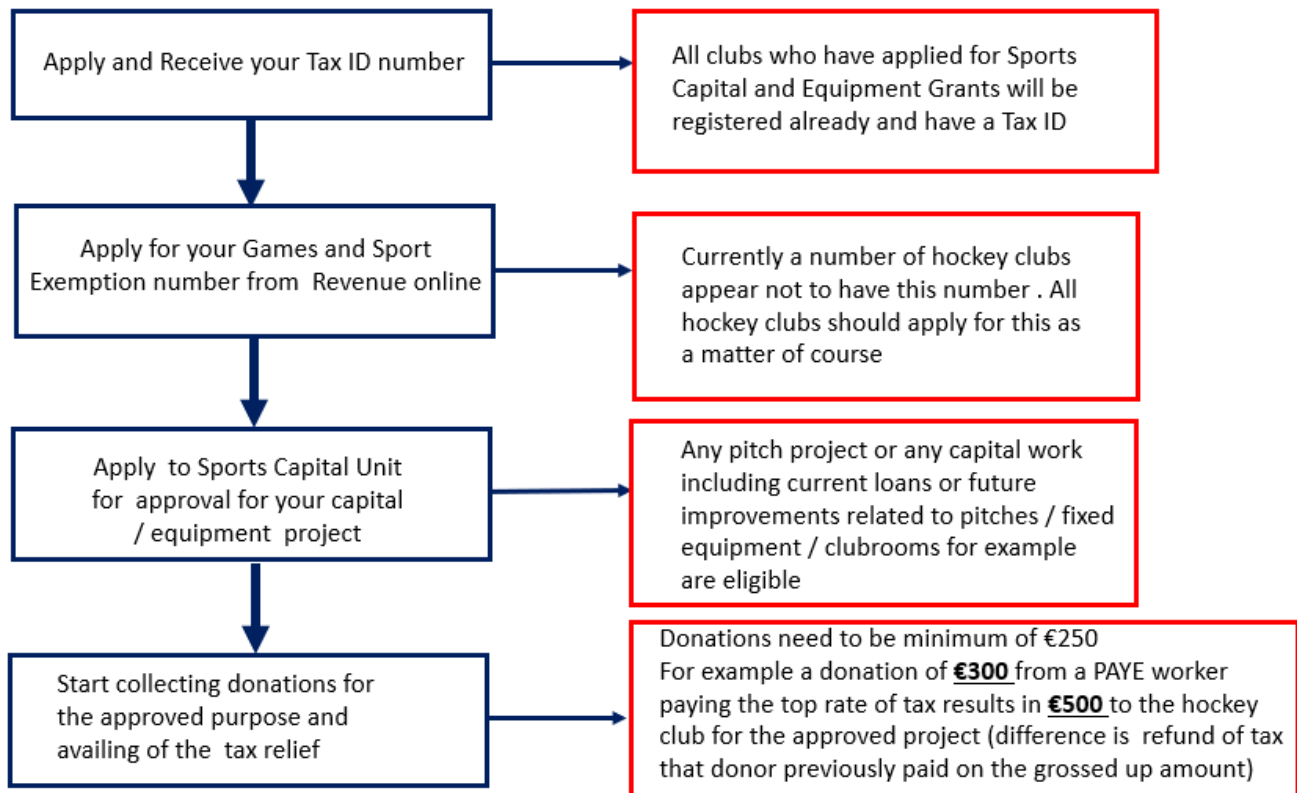


Does your Hockey Club avail of the Tax Relief on Donations to an Approved Sports Body Scheme?

All clubs including those who have applied for capital and non-personal fixed equipment under the recent SCEP scheme should apply for approval. The above link has all the up to date information on this scheme. It goes through step by step what a club needs to do to get approval and get their development project approved for tax relief. This scheme will be useful for clubs raising funds for reasons such as:

- Capital development involving pitch and or floodlights etc.
- Capital development of club room(s) / storage
- Purchase of fixed equipment i.e., scoreboard / match goals etc
- Loans or repayments still owing on any of the above incurred since May 1st 2002
